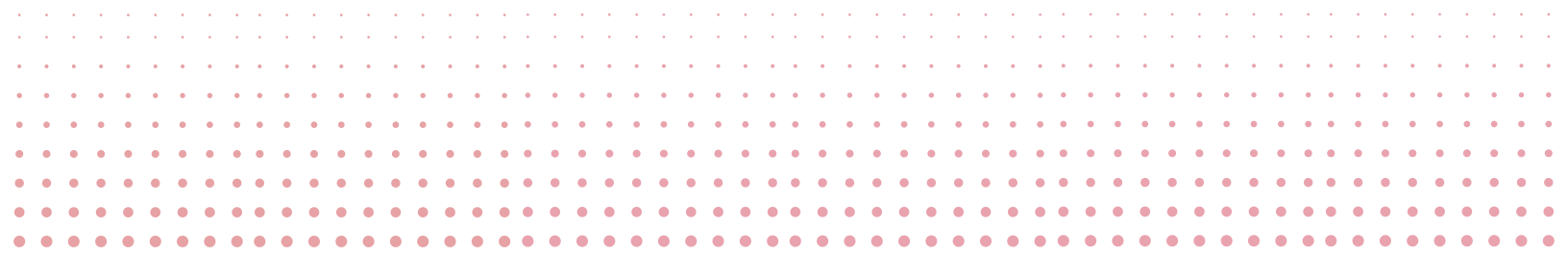

Outreach Dance Instructor

Position Overview:

This is a part-time position (1–2 days per week), typically scheduled between 2:00 PM – 5:00 PM at school sites.
